Course Description

Part one is an introduction to the study of Oral Pathology and Dental Pharmacology. Part two focuses on the role of the dental assistant when caring for compromised patients and in dealing with dental/medical emergencies in the dental office. Course learning outcomes

1. Recognize and describe a variety of disorders and conditions affecting the oral cavity, including the sources of information necessary for the dentist to make a diagnosis.
