# **Course Description**

Develops skills in pre-hospital assessment and care for patients of all ages with a variety of medical conditions and traumatic injuries. Part two of two-part emergency medical service National Standards Curriculum course. Students must complete an eight-hour "shift" emergency medical services agency ride-along.

## **Course learning outcomes**

- 1. Apply the basic concepts of mechanism of injury and pathophysiology to assessment and management of trauma patients.
- 2. Establish and/or maintain a patent airway, oxygenate, and ventilate a trauma patient.
- 3. Perform a proper history and comprehensive physical exam on a trauma patient and communicate the findings.
- 4. Integrate pathophysiological principles and assessment findings to formulate a field impression and implement a treatment plan for the trauma patient.
- 5. Safely manage the scene of an emergency involving multiple patients.
