# **Course Description**

Introduces students to jazz improvisation in a laboratory (performance) setting. No previous experience or knowledge about jazz or improvisation necessary. Students should have some previously developed proficiency on an instrument or voice. May be repeated, no limit.

#### **Course learning outcomes**

- 1. Perform several jazz rhythms in correct style.
- 2. Play easy scales, triads, and seventh chords from memory.
- 3. Solo against 8, 4, and 2-measure vamps.
- 4. Improvise through simple progressions including the "turn-around".
- 5. Perform songs in swing and Latin style.
- 6. Improvise the blues in minor and major keys.
- 7. Rhythm Section students will be able to accompany in the jazz style.
