BARCELONA 2022 NEWS



PLACES IN BARCELONA

Montseny Natural Park:

About an hour NE of Bacelona by train the Montseny Natural Park is on UNESCO World Network of Biosphere Reserves. This park is home to wonderful hikes both in the forest and looking out towards the sea and the Pyrenees. There are neolithic structures along with iron age and roman structures. Hikers pass through a range of ecosystems as they ascend the Montseny Massif over 1700 m (like climbing the South Sister) to reach various peaks. Some weekend when Barcelona feels a bit crowded I expect to find some solace at this park.
