### PLACES IN BARCELONA

#### Parc Guell:

Everyone I talk to about Barcelona makes a point of suggesting a visit to Parc Guell. Parc Guell is in the Gracia barrio of B arcelona and is quite accessible with the metro pass provided by Barcelona SAE. It appears that there is much to explore in this project of Antoni Gaudi (the architect of the Sagrada Famila). Parts of the park are free to enter and other portions have an entrance fee of 5 to 10 Euros. In 1984 Parc Guell was named a UNESCO World Heritage Site as party of Gaudi's body of work.
