CHECK YOUR PROGRAM

As a participant in the COCC Study Abroad program you are required to take a Spanish Language (or perhaps Catalan) class and HUM 107 Spanish Culture. These courses are taught by our partner Barcelona SAE. Bruce Emerson will be teaching 3 additional COCC courses, GS 104 Physics of Renewable Energy, GS 107 Astronomy in the Iberian Peninsula, and MUS 101 Music Fundamentals. Generally participants take all three of the additional courses. Each of these courses is intended to meet degree requirements for students but it is wise to verify how these courses will meet your particular needs. This may include thoughtful planning for Fall and Winter.

PLACES IN BARCELONA

Segeda (Zaragoza):

Humans have been in Spain for a very long time. For many it is surprising that there is an ancient celtic culture in Spain. This is often referred to as the Celtiberian culture. Near Zaragoza is a pre-Roman city currently referred to as Segeda. Segeda was a significant center in the cultures along the Ebro River which meets the sea near Barcelona. Like many celtic cultures public spaces in Segeda have astronomical significance which we will explore in GS 107.
